## ORDINANCE NO. 58

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #52 ADOPTED  
JULY 29, 1981 WHICH ORDINANCE AMENDED ORDINANCE #14  
OF SEPTEMBER 4, 1973

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Bucks, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

1. Section 2E of Ordinance No. 52, adopted July 29, 1981 is hereby deleted, and in its place instead, the provisions of the following amended Section 2E are adopted.

2. Section 41 - Penalties and Enforcement E

E. The Bucks County Park Rangers shall be able to carry weapons only as follows:

1. Rangers may carry a weapon concealed in their vehicle during daytime patrol hours during period from dawn to dusk.

2. Rangers may carry a weapon concealed on their person so as not to be visible by any person, during patrol hours after dusk and before dawn only.

3. These concealed weapons may be used only in the act of self-protection or the protection of a park patron/patrons from a life threatening situation.

4. These weapons may not be used to effectuate an arrest or even for detention of an individual for a citation or ordinance violation.

5. These concealed weapons as aforesaid are for person protection while the ranger performs his duties within the boundaries of the County Parks only.

6. Before any ranger may possess and carry a concealed weapon he/she must pass psychological testing administered by the County and furthermore must qualify annually at a certified weapons range in handling of said weapon.

3. All other provisions of said Ordinance #14 and #52, where the same are not inconsistent herewith, are ratified and confirmed.


4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
